- DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT: THE PROJECT HAS AMONG ITS OBJECTIVES EDUCATION TO DIVERSITY, TO MULTICULTURALISM UNDERSTOOD NOT AS THE JUXTAPOSITION OF DIFFERENT CULTURES, BUT AS A PATH OF COMMON LIVING, IN WHICH ALL THE DIVERSITIES ARE RECOGNIZED, WHETHER THEY ARE OF THE TYPE RELIGIOUS, SOCIAL, ECONOMIC, POLITICAL, CULTURAL, GENDER AND SEXUAL ORIENTATION IN A COMMON LEGAL FRAMEWORK. THROUGH THE PROJECT WE WOULD THEREFORE LIKE TO:
- 1.TRAIN AND EDUCATE YOUNG PEOPLE READY TO ACCEPT THE CHALLENGES OF CULTURAL DIVERSITY
- 2.SPREAD THE CONCEPT THAT EVERY PERSON IS A GLOBAL CITIZEN, RESPONSIBLE FOR HUMANITY, THE PLANET AND THE FUTURE.
- 3.SHARE INFORMATION ON IMMIGRATION ANALYZED FROM VARIOUS POINTS OF VIEW
- 4. KNOW WHAT ARE THE REASONS FOR EMIGRATION;
- 5. UNDERSTAND THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN PUSH AND PULL FACTORS;
- 6. ANALYZE THE EFFECTS OF MIGRATION ON PEOPLE AND COMMUNITIES.
- 7. KNOWING HOW TO DECLINE THE CONCEPT OF CITIZENSHIP IN ITS VARIOUS MEANINGS;
- 8. KNOW THE DIFFERENT SOLUTIONS THAT HAVE BEEN ADOPTED IN THE MIGRATION DESTINATION COUNTRIES REGARDING THE RIGHT TO CITIZENSHIP



• GROUP LEADER:

EVERY COUNTRY TEAM IS REPRESENTED BY ONE TEAM LEADER.

THE COUNTRY ORGANIZATION SHALL CHOOSE THE GROUP LEADER VERY SMART, IN ORDER TO PROVIDE QUALITY PREPARATION OF THE TEAM MEMBERS, TO PROVIDE GOOD COMMUNICATION BETWEEN THE HOSTING TEAM AND THE COUNTRY TEAM, AND TO FOLLOW AND SUPPORT THE TEAM MEMBERS WHILE THE TRAVEL AND THE EXCHANGE DURATION.

• WHO IS THE TEAM LEADER:

HE/SHE IS A YOUTH WORKER
(VOLUNTEER, COORDINATOR, TRAINER, AND ETC) IN
THE SENDING PARTNER ORGANIZATION. HE/SHE
SHOULD BE OLDER THAN 18 YEARS OLD, WITH
PROVEN EXPERIENCE IN YOUTH WORK AND AS A
TEAM LEADER.




WE SUGGEST DURING THE PROCESS OF SELECTION OF THE CANDIDATES TO TAKE THE FOLLOWING INTO CONSIDERATION:

- CANDIDATES' LEARNING NEEDS
- THEIR LEARNING OBJECTIVES
- THEIR EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES
- AGE (18-25)
- GENDER (PROVIDE A GENDER BALANCE)
- MOTIVATION (WHY THEY WANT TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS PROJECT?)
- THEIR AVAILABILITY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROJECT (EVERY PARTICIPANT SHALL ENGAGE AND FULFILL THE PROJECT ACTIVITIES AND TASKS, BEFORE, DURING, AND AFTER THE MOBILITY);
- THEIR SPECIAL NEEDS (YOUNG PEOPLE WITH FEWER OPPORTUNITIES).

- 1. TO ESTABLISH A CONTACT PERSON AND TO SELECT THE EXPERIENCED GROUP LEADER FROM OWN ORGANIZATION
- 2. TO SELECT AND PREPARE THE PARTICIPANTS THAT WILL PARTICIPATE IN THE YOUTH EXCHANGE
- 3. TO SUPPORT THE GROUP LEADER AND THE YOUNG PARTICIPANTS IN ESTABLISHING THEIR TRAVEL PLAN;
- 4. TO GET INVOLVED IN ESTABLISHING THE CODE OF CONDUCT AND TO BE SURE THAT ALL ACTORS INVOLVED (CONTACT PERSON, GROUP LEADER, AND PARTICIPANTS) ARE ASSUMING IT;
- 5. TO INFORM THE PARTICIPANTS AND THE GROUP LEADER ABOUT THE DETAILS OF THE PROJECT;
- 6. TO SHARE THE TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES TROUGH THE TEAM AND TO ASSIST THE PARTICIPANTS TO FULFILL THEM;
- 7. TO ENSURE THAT THE PROJECT OUTCOMES AND ERASMUS HAS VISIBILITY TROUGH PUBLICATION OF THE ARTICLE, PHOTOS, SHARING VISUAL CONTENT, SHARING AND DISSEMINATION OF THE PROJECT INTELLECTUAL OUTPUTS AND SIMILAR
- 8. TO COORDINATE THE TRAVEL OF THEIR TEAM AND THE REIMBURSEMENT
- 9. TO ORGANIZE AND EXECUTE DISSEMINATION ACTIVITIES AND SUBMIT PROFESSOR IT TO THE COORDINATOR ORGANIZATION
- 10. TO MAKE A SHORT REPORT AT THE END OF THE PROJECT
- 11. TO RESPECT THE DEADLINES AND TO WORK TOGETHER WITH THE COORDINATOR PARTNER FOR FULFILLING THE GOALS.

All the reimbursements will be done via bank transfer to the partner/participant bank account after receiving all the documents requested. It might take some months after the YE in order to arrange all the documents and receive the money for travel costs from ITALIAN NA.

We will reimburse the travel cost for the partecipants according to the distance band.

In some case and in agreement with the organization, we can even buy the tickets. But we need the list of participants asap so we can do everyhting in time. We will contact every organization by mail.

According to the restrictions of the Erasmus+ Programme, we can only refund the travel cost, if the following points are fulfilled:


- 1) Your travel route is from your place of residence to the venue in ITALY (Poggiardo) and back.
- 2) You have chosen reasonable and economic means of transportation (e.g. cheap airlines, 2nd class trains).
 - 3) Your travel dates are according to the programme
 - 4) You have all documents to prove your travel (invoices, tickets, boarding passes).

Nearest airport is in BRINDISI! From there we will pick you up by bus if you request so. The cost of the bus is around 20 Euro per person; please consider it in your budget. The train from Brindisi to Lecce costs approximately 10-15 Euros.

Alternatively, you can arrive in BARI, if you can find bette<mark>r con</mark>nection, we will send you a bus to pick you up and the cost is 35 Euro per person. The train from Bari to Lecce costs approximately 15-20 Euros.

Alternatively, you can arrive to ROMA and from Roma take a train to LECCE. If you choose this option, you can find info and time table at www.trenitalia.it

From Lecce to Poggiardo, please see <u>www.fseonline.it</u> . T<mark>he t</mark>rain from Lecce goes to Poggiardo a couple of times a day and the one-way ticket costs 2 Euros.

climate.

The summer seasons are particularly muggy but often windy, while the winter seasons are mainly mild, but is may be very cold or even freezing days, especially in the presence of northeast wind from the neighboring Balkans.

The Salento countryside is almost everywhere cultivated, and the arboreal vegetation is mostly made up of expanses of secular olive trees, with twisted and large trunks.

The landed property is generally divided into small plots, separated by the typical dry stone walls. The stone has always been used also to make various dry constructions, used by farmers to rest or to store work tools.



The sea takes on a dark blue color when observed from the high cliffs overlooking the Adriatic Sea, and emerald green, green, light blue, if observed from the sandy beaches of the Ionian Sea.




The countries, generally sparsely populated, have a typically Mediterranean appearance and are characterized by the intense white of the buildings which makes them dazzling on sunny days.

SALENTO FLORA



The flora in Salento is estimated to number

around 1,500 species. In addition to the

aforementioned centuries-old olive groves

and vineyardsthat characterize the territory, the

vegetation is also mainly composed of the prickly

pear, which grows spontaneously both inland

and along the coast, from the fig tree, which

gives its sweet fruits at the end of summer and

from the almond tree, which begins to usually

bloom in February. In spring, the land under the

olive trees, the edge of the paths and roads, as

well as the interstices of the dry stone walls, are

covered with flowers in a chromatic explosion

ranging from the red of the poppies to the yellow

with the green of the Mediterranean scrub. The

polychrome berries then announce

the autumn and the following mild winter.

As regards the fauna of Salento, there are numerous species of birds such as the crane, the gray heron (Ardea cinerea), the mallard (Anas platyrhynchos), the bittern (Botaurus stellaris), the sea jay (Coracias garrulus), the Turkish fistione (Netta rufina), the kestrel (Falco tinnunculus), as well as numerous species of reptiles, such as lizards and geckos, of mammals, such as hedgehogs, foxes and martens, and arthropods, such asscorpions, tarantula and lepidoptera such as Amata phegea
