### WHERE ARE WE NOW:

# WHERE WE WILL BE:

In 2023, we will move to another area with more than 6ha where we will placed new and larger facilities based on the principles of permaculture. These new facilities, aim to be an international reference project of permaculture and ecology.

# PROJECT SUMMARY



### YOUTH EXCHANGE ACTIVITIES

This activity is a Youth Exchange and aims to develop important personal skills for young people trough non-formal education, such as improving their communication skills, their level of English, the ability to take decisions, speak loudly or make public presentations, to achieve self-confidence and personal experience.

Besides, another relevant objective is **the strengthening of European links and interconnection among youngsters.** Youth exchanges, allow groups of young people from different countries to meet, live together and work on shared projects for short periods in the context of the European Union.

Participants, who are the main actors of a Youth Exchange, must be deeply involve during the activities. Therefore, their aptitude should be pro-active and dynamic.

### FROM 10TH TO 17TH OF JANUARY 2022

The main activity of this project is a 7 day-Youth Exchange targeted to people between 18 and 30 years old. It is carried out by Permacultura Cantabria in Cantabria (Spain).

This Youth Exchange 'Tools for mental health in youth' (2020-1-ES02-KA105-014953) aims to exchange and provide, to our youngsters, a set of tools, knowledges and dynamics, to create healthy and collaborative environments, to prevent depression and addictions.

This Youth Exchange 'Tools for mental health in youth' (2020-1-ES02-KA105-014953) aims to achieve the objectives below through dance and dancing:

- Providing young people with the tools to create healthy and collaborative spaces through dance.
- Increasing the abilities of youngsters to **promote youth participation in**European and civic activities and sharing dance and movement tools.
- Building up **ideas that lead to future collaborations**, within the framework of the different key actions of the Erasmus + program.

To achieve the purpose of this youth exchange, we propose to each entity to select youngsters who meet the following requirements:

- 1. They should like dance and dancing.
- 2. They are supposed to **lead at least a 2 hour session** to share their dance techniques and skills. (Not essential but highly recommended)
- 3. Participants must be able to **speak and understand English** to communicate during the Youth Exchange.

During this activity, there will be a person in charge of logistics, a main facilitator and two experts in contemporary dance. All of them will boost all the areas of exchanging and learning.

# NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS:

There will be 42 participants in this activity 7 per entity:

Participants from Croatia (7), Poland (7), Italy (7), UK (7), Romania (7) and Spain (7) will be part of this activity.

This youth exchange is open to people between the ages of 18 and 30.



# TRANSPORT RELEVANT INFORMATION REGARDING COVID19



**Due to the CO-VID 19 crisis Permacultura Cantabria wants to clarify some issues:** 

The situation in our Region, Cantabria, is not so risky as in other Spanish Regions. The number of citizens affected by COVID-19 is very low and still under control. However, our Regional Government can impose travel restrictions, at any moment, in order to prevent a collapse of our health-care system. Therefore, this mobility could be affected.

Each sending entity should have a list of participants and a travel/flights proposal ready, before the 10th of December (one month before the course start). That date, this information must be shared with Permacultura Cantabria, who will determine, then, after consulting the authorities' recommendations, if it is possible or NOT to carry out the mobility and therefore, to proceed with the flights' purchase.

Sending entities or participants WILL NOT BUY any flight tickets, before consulting with Permacultura Cantabria and receiving our agreement.

To enter Spain, participants should comply with the COVID measures implemented by the Spanish Government (<a href="https://www.spth.gob.es">https://www.spth.gob.es</a>) such us:

- A) To bring the EU Digital COVID Certificate with you. This certificate could be obtained if the traveler:
- 1. Has been vaccinated at least 14 days prior to arrival in Spain.
- 2. Has recovered from COVID-19 (check the valid period on the website).
- 3. Has had a diagnostic test, within 48 hours prior to arrival in Spain with negative result.
- B) To fill out a health control form (FCS) and get a Health QR Code that you will have to show (paper or mobile) at the airport health control.

Participants should also accept the COVID protocols implemented by the participating entities, signing a statement of responsibility before traveling.

# HOW TO GET TO SPAIN:

#### **Santander Airport**

These are the best options to arrive and the links to find timetables and make reservations:

It is 15 minutes far from the city center. It is a local airport, which counts with low cost airlines like RYANAIR. The rest of flights could be expensive.

It is probably one of the best options. It is a small airport, but much more active than Santander's. It is located outside of the city of Bilbao.

# HOW TO REACH THE VENUE PLACE:

The activity will take place, mainly, in the municipality of Penagos, in Permacultura Cantabria's facilities.

Penagos is not so well connected in terms of public transport.

There are a few daily buses from Santander.

# OTHER OPTION:

The best and easiest option that has worked for everyone before, is to HIRE A CAR.

This is the preferred choice for most entities since it provides freedom of movement during the activity (a quite cheap option for groups of 3-4 people).

The prices for a car rental (in Santander or Bilbao airport) are around 20 euros per day, depending on the car's engine. We recommend you to use this company:


#### BUS

Step 1: Bilbao Airport to San Mamés Bus Station: To get to Bilbao's bus station, there are <u>buses from the airport</u> every 30 minutes. The cost is approximately 1,45€. It is the public bus line (Bizkaibus) and the line number is A3247.

Step 2: San Mamés Bus Station to Santander. Buy tickets at <u>ALSA</u> company, approximately 6,90€. Please consult the time schedules on the website.

Step 3: Santander Bus Station to Penagos: Buy the tickets at <u>ALSA</u> company, El Arenal de Penagos. The cost is approximately 2,25 euros. Please consult the time schedules on the website.


#### BUS

Step 1: Airport to Santander: In order to go to Santander, you have <u>buses</u>, every 30 minutes, taking only 10 minutes to the city centre.

Step 2: Santander Bus Station to Penagos: Buy the tickets at <a href="ALSA">ALSA</a> company, El Arenal de Penagos. The cost is approximately 2,25 euros. Please consult the time schedules on the website.

### PRIVATE TRANSPORT

#### TAXI - BILBAO TO PENAGOS

The taxi option will only be available for special timing, such as late at night or very early in the morning. Its price is around 80 euros per taxi and 100€ per taxi at night.

#### TAXI - SANTANDER TO PENAGOS

The taxi option will only be available for special timing, such as late at night or very early in the morning. Its price is around 40 euros per taxi and 60€ per taxi at night.



# PERMACULTURA CAN MANAGE YOUR TRANSPORTATION

Permacultura Cantabria can also manage your transportation from Bilbao and Santander to reach the venue (round trip).

Once the sending entity inform us about the travel plan, we will be able to know all participant's flights details. With this, we will make groups according to your time and place of arrival so that one car can take you to the venue.

Each room has 2 or 3 beds, so they are ready for 2 or 3 people.





# IMPORTANT THINGS TO TAKE

### PERSONAL DOCUMENTS

#### **PASSPORT**

To enter Spain, you need a **valid identity document** (passport or identity card).

#### VISA

Whether you need a Visa for entry depends on your nationality. Citizens of EU and EFTA countries do not need a Visa.

If you need a Visa, make sure you apply for it immediately because it can take a long time. If you need an invitation or confirmation letter from Permacultura Cantabria, please let us know.





As a member of the European Union, Spain has agreements for the recognition of insurance systems. Those who possess a **European insurance card** should therefore be covered for illness and accidents in the same way as they are in their country, so please bring this card with you.

In any case, please remember that health insurance as well as travel insurance is your responsibility, we assume no liability knowing that EU health card is enough. So, do not forget to **check & bring your insurance card with you!**

The currency in Spain is the **Euro**. You will need to bring money only if you need something for the travel or if you want to buy personal things (like presents for your family or if you wish to go out).




# **W**EATHER




